The Cesymbol alone is not sufficient to ensure consistent standards of manufacture. The PAS 015: 1998 and Snell E2001meet higher impact criteria and therefore give more protection. Body protectors, long sleeves and medical armbands must be worn for the cross country classes. And also worn any time you use the cross country. The organisers reserve the right to disqualify anyone for misuse of whip or spurs, dangerous riding or for any horse/pony in poor or lame condition. Stopwatches are not allowed in any class.

Horses/ponies must not be left unattended outside at any time.

The organisers reserve the right to limit or refuse any entry, if deemed necessary, without giving any reason.

HORSE RIDING IS A HIGH RISK SPORT. The organisers except no responsibility for any injury, loss or damage what so ever whilst you are at Field Farm.

Correct dress to be worn for each class Spurs and whips are permitted in all classes except games, horse and hound and chase me charlie.

THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL. ANY COMPLAINT MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A FEE OF £20 TO BE RETURNED ONLY IF COMPLAINT IS UPHELD

Dogs must be kept on a lead and under control at all times.you MUST clean up after your dog. Litter incl. Horse dropping, shavings, hay and straw must be cleared away before leaving the grounds.
